Round 3 – Celebrities. Here are photos of some famous celebrities that have been distorted. Name these celebrities. (First and Last name please)

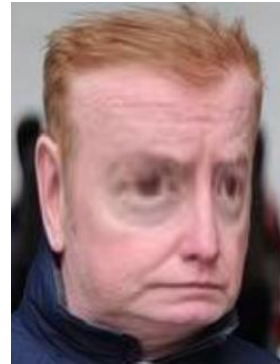

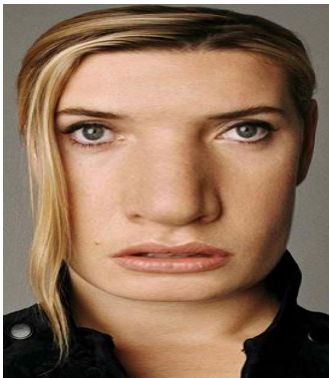

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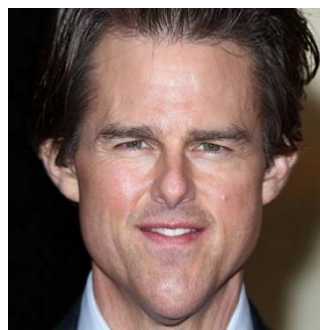

Round 4. People born in June. I'll read out some clues to famous people who were born in June. You need to name them, please. At least the last name unless they are royalty in which case I want the Regnal name

1. A Coventry born inventor who developed the jet engine. Born 1 June 1907
2. A classical composer, who is revered each year in the *Last Night of the Proms* concert with his *Pomp and Circumstance* march. Born 2 June 1857
3. The King of Great Britain, who during World War I abandoned all German titles for himself and his family and changed the name of the royal house from Saxe-Coburg-Gotha to Windsor. Born 3 June 1865
4. A famous Antarctic explorer whose team reached the South Pole shortly after Norwegian Roald Amundsen on 18 Jan 1912. Born 6 June 1868
5. An English physician, who after studying privately, pioneered the admission of women to the medical profession. Born 9 June 1836
6. He is one of the greatest British landscape artists, who found his inspirations just a few miles from his Suffolk home at *Flatford Mill* and *The Valley Farm*. Born 11 June 1776
7. An English-born comedian who went to the USA to seek fame and fortune, and found both making films with partner Oliver Hardy. Born 16 June 1890
8. An Indian born English novelist, whose best known works include *Animal Farm* and *Nineteen Eighty-Four*. Born 25 June 1903
9. Sir Henry Rider Haggard, novelist best known for his African adventures including *King Solomon's Mines* and *She*. Born 22 June 1856
10. A Scottish civil engineer and builder of lighthouses who developed the now familiar intermittent (flashing) lights. Often confused with his namesake who built the Rocket Steam Train. Born 8 June 1772
