
Round 1 – General Knowledge (A possible 10 points)



Round 4. Scientific Processes. Here are some descriptions of Scientific processes. I'll also give you the initial. What is the process please?

1. The process by which a liquid is changed to a solid state when it is cooled. (F).
Freezing
2. The loss of electrons and gain of oxygen which can result in rusting or corrosion. (O)
Oxidation
3. The process by which a liquid turns into a vapour (E)
Evaporation
4. The process where a solid turns straight into gas without first becoming a liquid(S)
Sublimation eg Dry Ice
5. The process of using yeast or other micro-organisms to convert sugars, often into alcohol (F)
Fermentation
6. The action of plants using light energy to convert water and carbon dioxide into oxygen (P)
Photosynthesis
7. The process by which food that is eaten is broken down into other substances (D)
Digestion
8. The emission of energy in the form of particles or electromagnetic waves (R)
Radiation
9. The change in direction of a wave as it passes from one medium to another caused by its change in speed (R)
Refraction
10. The wave-like muscular contractions that 'squeeze' or push food along the oesophagus to the stomach. (P)
Peristalsis
